Pope Tractor Pull General Rules:

- 1. Cost will be \$20 per hook.
- 2. **Pay Out will be:** 1st place, \$45; 2nd place \$30; & 3rd place \$20. Pay Out is Half if the class size is less than 6
- 3. **Pit Passes are \$20**: Must be 18 year's old, or 16 with a parents signed waiver
- 4. Each Tractor may only be entered in 1 class only. Double hooks for the same tractor in the same class is not allowed, unless there is an opening in that same class the day of the pull.
- 5. Classes are listed as first to register, last to pull. This encourages early entry of classes.
- 6. Classes are limited to 10 per class, unless permitted by the committee to allow extra.
- 7. **Drivers must be 18 year's old** or 16 with parent's consent.
- 8. **Driver must be present for the 4:30 PM** driver safety meeting.
- 9. **Tractor max weight is posted class weight** with driver aboard.
- 10. **Minimum drawbar length 18 inches from center of rear axle to point of hook** and may not pull from the 2-Point or 3-Point hitch mechanisms.
- 11. No weight frame or weights may extend 11 feet from center of rear axel.
- 12. All weights must be safely secured to the tractor, rear weights must not interfere with hooking to the sled.
- 13. If anything falls off during your pull you will be disqualified!
- 14. Just before pulling, the puller will be weighed again, and must be weighed before moving into staging.
- 15. **Puller must operate in a safe manner at all times**, operates must remain seated during the pull with at least one hand on the steering wheel.
- 16. Must be in neutral when being hook and unhooked.
- 17. All pulls must start from a tight hitch, no jerking permitted.
- 18. **Driver is allowed one restart before the cross of the 100' mark**, if you cross the out of bounds line or drop anything before 100' you will also be disqualified, and not allowed to restart.
- 19. **Tractor and skid must remain in the boundaries at all times** during the course of the pull, or you will be disqualified.
- 20. **Driver must stop immediately upon signal from the judge**. The pull is over when forward motion discontinues.
- 21. Failure to allow inspection by judges will result in disqualification.
- 22. Contest to be governed by the judges with all decisions final.
- 23. **No arguing with or use of poor language** is allowed to any of the Promoters, Pull Officials, People teching or operators. If there is a problem, you and your crew will be asked to leave.
- 24. No alcohol is permitted in the pit area!
- 25. No one under 16 allowed in the pit area!

Pick-up truck classes:

A. Factory stock Gas only 6,200 lbs.

Factory stock as delivered from the factory, weights are permitted in this class, but must remain in the front of the bed only.

B. Modified stock Gas only 6,500 lbs.

Must be stock as delivered from factory with up to 3 modifications to improve performance. Must be street legal and/or licensable. Engine size limit up to 500 cubic inches, and only one carb permitted. No alcohol or pressurized fuel systems. Front weights and brackets not to exceed 60" from center of front axle of the pick-up.

C. Factory stock Diesel only 9,000 lbs.

Factory stock as delivered from the factory, weights are permitted in this class, but must remain in the front of the bed only.

All pick-up's: Hitching point must not exceed 26" from the bottom of pulling point to the ground. Must provide you own clevis.

Antique Tractor Classes:

- A. **4,500 lbs**: Max Tire size 13.6 x 38 or 14.9 x 28
- B. **5,200 lbs**: Max Tire size 14.9 x 38; 15.5 x 38; or 16.9 x 34
- C. **6,000 lbs**: Max Tire size 14.9 x 38; 15.5 x 38; or 16.9 x 34
- D. **7,500 lbs**: Max Tire size 18.4 x 38; 16.9 x 38; or 18.4 x 28
- E. **9,000 lbs**: Max Tire size 18.4 x 38; 16.9 x 38; or 18.4 x 28
- F. **10,500 lbs**: Max Tire size 18.4 x 38; 16.9 x 38; or 18.4 x 28
- G. 12,000 lbs: Max Tire size 20.8 x 38 or 18.4 x 38

All antique tractors:

- A. Tractors must be 40 years old or older.
- B. Class speed limit is 5 mph.
- **C. Stamped wheels are allowed.** No drive aluminum wheel allowed. No cut tires allowed. Must have rubber tires.
- **D.** You are allowed one warning horn for exceed the speed limit. The second horn you will be disqualified.

Stock out of field classes:

- A. 15,000 lbs: No tire limit size
- B. 21,000 lbs: No tire limit size
- C. 28,000 lbs: No tire limit size
- D. 35,000 lbs: No tire limit size

All stock out of field tractors:

- A. Tractor must be factory stock.
- B. No class speed limit.

Hot Farm Classes:

- A. 9,500 lbs: Refer to rules from https://www.cmppullers.com/rules
- B. 11,500 lbs: Refer to rules from https://www.cmppullers.com/rules

All tractors: Drawbar height must not exceed 20" in height, or less than 18" from the center of the rear axle to the hooking point. No part of the drawbar may extend beyond the hook point. Drawbars must be stationary in all directions and have a 3" hole or clevis.

Semi-Truck classes:

A. Stock on-highway semi truck's: No weight limit

All Semi's: Must be licensed and registered for highway travel, and must have operating fifth wheel plate. Semi-Truck Hitches are provided.
